SELECTION FOR THE 3RD GRADE



A maximum of 28 students are selected for the group.

Special emphasis continues throughout primary school.

Entrance exam 24.1.2023 at 8.00 – 10.00. Meeting at Merivalkama 9.

N.B! No separate invitation will be sent to the entrance examination.

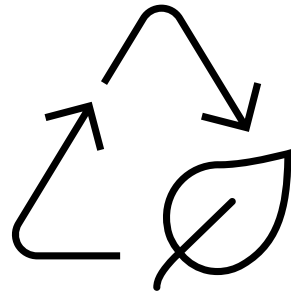

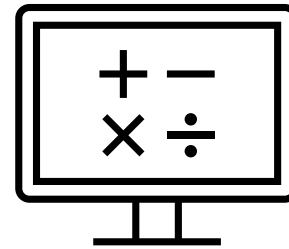
ENTRANCE EXAMINATION



In the entrance examination, knowledge, skills and competencies are tested in accordance with the curriculum of the 2nd grade. It is not allowed to use a translator program in the exam.



Natural sciences 30p.



Mathematics 30p.

The student needs to pass both parts of the exam (min 10p). Students are selected based on scores. In the event of a tie, the order is drawn.

STEM-STUDY

- exploratory, experiential and experiential learning
- aims to develop the pupil's own thinking extensively
- strengthening the pupil's positive relationship with the environment and nature, as well as problem-solving skills

A STEM-STUDENT

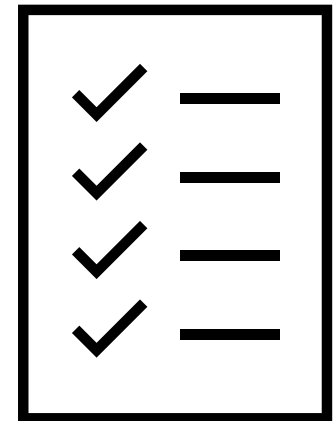
- Is an active participant, observer, thinker and debater

A student can apply to a maximum of two schools. The desired weightings are put in order.

1) Preferred choice

2) Secondary choice

The application request is binding.

PROBLEMS APPLYING



Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

If applying for weighting requires the submission of separate attachments or applications, the guardian must submit them within the set deadline.

If a pupil is ill on the day of the entrance examination, notify the principal of Meritori School before the entrance exam begins. A new examination can only be arranged upon presentation of a medical certificate.



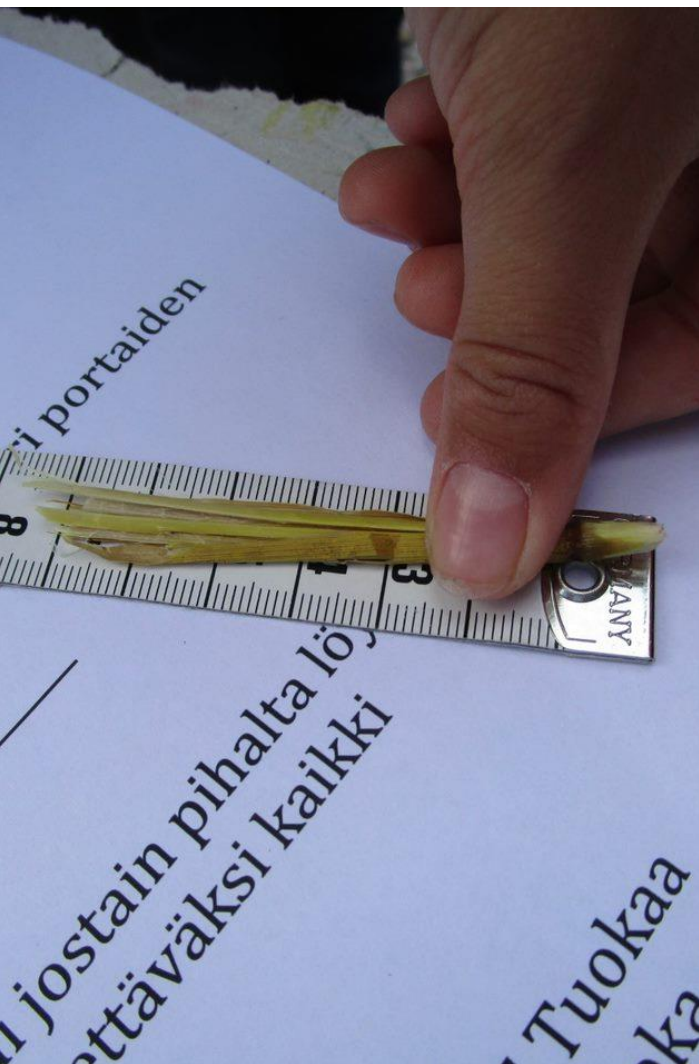
SELECTION INFORMATION
